1. What major problem or issue is being resolved and how are you resolving it?

To make the most efficient use of Initiative resources, it is important for Initiative members to have access to current information regarding the Initiative. The Initiative's website (www.scabusa.org) provides this information, including but not limited to research areas, news, annual forums, literature, and useful links. The site also includes a ColdFusion-based web-accessible database (the USWBSI database) which simplifies the process of querying and downloading the information.

The Initiative's web site is continuously update and maintained. The appearance, organization, and content of the site has improved significantly. In addition, the USWBSI database is being improved and expanded. The web site and database will hopefully be expanded to include information on the Initiative's research efforts, such as methods, results, and publications.

2. What were the most significant accomplishments?

Substantial improvements and optimizations have been made to the existing public and administrative ColdFusion applications of the USWBSI database. Additional applications providing enhanced functionality have been developed as needed.

Web applications to facilitate online forum registration and ordering of forum proceedings, as well as applications for administering the information have been developed and continuously improved.

Regarding system administration of the scabusa.org server, various security software tools have been installed, configured and maintained in order to bring the Initiative's server into compliance with strict USDA/ARS computer security guidelines. The server software being employed (including HTTP, SMTP, POP, SSH) is continuously monitored and maintained. In addition, periodic backups are made of all critical Initiative data housed on the server. Utilities have been developed to facilitate and automate theses backups.

General improvements have been made to the appearance, organization, and content of the web site.
